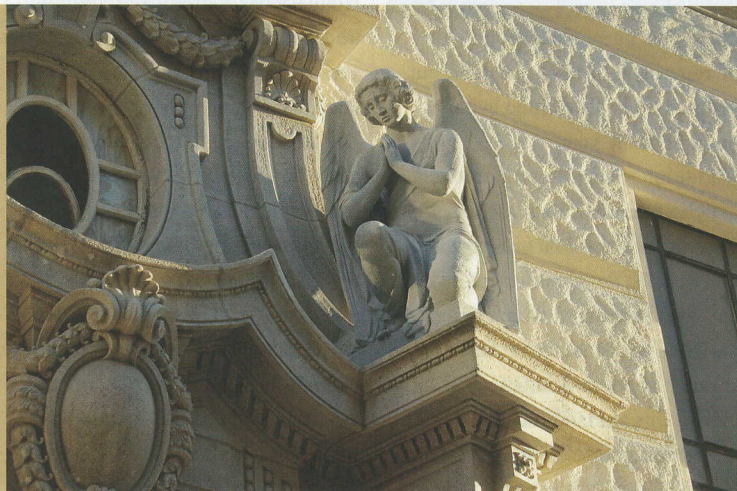

Certification according to ISO 9001 was granted in 2001, complemented by EMI Certified Trade Contractor Business Certifica-

tion. The company that started out as a general contractor in 1990 has experienced continuous and successful development and has grown with the complexity of its tasks. "We decided to produce plastic windows in response to the tremendous market demand in Hungary at the time," explains Attila Holman, founder, qualified engineer and joint managing director together with his brother László. "The refinement and quality of our products gained us orders in the reconstruction and restoration sector, which has become the mainstay of our business in the meantime."

Today, Confektor works with a permanent staff of 40 to 50 persons and generates annual sales volumes between 1.5 and 4 billion HUF, depending on the situation of the construction industry. The cooperation with subcontractors allows for a high level of flexibility, and thanks to its exceptional financial stability, Confektor is largely unaffected by market fluctuations. "We have always reinvested our profits and never borrowed money," confirms Mr. Holman. "This is one of the reasons why we have been able not only to outlast the crisis, but come through it very well."

The reputation gained over the years is another factor to count on, as Confektor is preparing to continue its course of success in an environment where values such as stability and reliability are more important than ever. The company offers general contracting services for institutional and public buildings, residential projects and family homes. The production of doors and windows comprises plastic doors and windows, special plastic systems, aluminium doors and windows, aluminium entrance doors and accessories.
